U block the power of figurative language for readers and writers with mentor texts. Smekens Education presents **Figurative Language Findings**—seven popular books dissected for the best excerpts for each of fifteen types of figurative language. Each listing is placed in the scaffolded order required by the Common Core State Standards (i.e., onomatopoeia*, simile, metaphor, idiom, adage/proverb, allusion, personification, alliteration, analogy, irony, pun, euphemism, oxymoron, hyperbole, paradox).

Lord of the Flies is a featured figurative language example for grades 9-12. Use the excerpts for both reading and writing mini-lessons to help students understand the meaning behind the figurative language.

*Onomatopoeia is not required by the CCSS, however, it is a type of figurative language represented in text.

Before *The Hunger Games* there was *Lord of the Flies*.
Lord of the Flies remains as provocative today as when it was first published in 1954, igniting passionate debate with its startling, brutal portrait of human nature. Though critically acclaimed, it was largely ignored upon its initial publication. Yet soon it became a cult favorite among both students and literary critics who compared it to J.D. Salinger's *The Catcher in the Rye* in its influence on modern thought and literature.
Labeled a parable, an allegory, a myth, a morality tale, a parody, a political treatise, even a vision of the apocalyptic, *Lord of the Flies* has established itself as a true classic.
